Finals Eligibility





Grade Settings (Association Administrators Only)

Do you have a Finals Eligibility criteria for your league? If so, make sure you have this grade setting turned on. It's okay to turn this on at any time during the season. If finals eligibility is ON and a player has not qualified, they cannot be added to a lineup without being made eligible.


Note: if you make a change to the default grade season this will not be reflected in grades, you will need to make the changes in each individual grade settings.

Set the minimum number of games a player is required to play for a team before they are eligible to represent that team in finals games.

Locating Eligibility Details

The number of games required to be eligible for finals is set by the Association Administrator. As a club, to find out how many games are required, navigate to your team page which will contain grade details on the right hand column.

In this example, the player (Jo Jacobs) has not met the Finals Eligibility criteria. Association Administrators have the ability to Edit Finals Eligibility Status of any participants who have played a game for that team.



Override Finals Eligibility (Association Administrators Only)

If a player has not met the Finals Eligibility criteria, they will appear in the non-eligible players list within the Edit Finals Eligibility Status page. To override the eligibility status, simply click the Make Eligible button.




Impact Of Permits And Transfers On Finals Eligibility

If a player is included in a team based on a game permit (GP), season permit (SP) or has transferred then come back to play for the team, multiple records for that player will exist in the Games Played Report. The number in the Games Played column will need to be combined to get a view of total games played and therefore their finals eligibility.



Navigation: Reports > Competitions > Games Played Report



Note: Notice how the same participant has appeared twice as separate records. Ensure that you search for duplicate records, then total up the number of games played and if eligible, override the participants finals eligibility.

Make Sure A Player On Season Permit Has A Valid Permit For Finals

It's important that a season permit (SP) player, if expecting to play finals, has a valid permit that covers the finals series date range. This permit still needs to be approved by an **Association Administrator** who will also need to provide a finals exemption via the *Edit Finals Eligibility Status* page. If multiple permit records appear, they will all need to be made eligible for finals.
